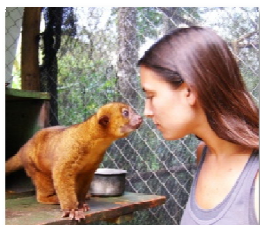

Group size: Minimum group size is 10 participants

Available date: All around the year

What it includes:
